Before Calling You Will Need:

- 1) A touchtone telephone.
- 2) A site-specific permit number.
- 3) An inspection code (refer to the **Inspection Codes** list).

Schedule an Inspection:

- 1) Press '1' to schedule an inspection.*
- 2) Enter the permit type (PMT or MHP).
- 3) Enter the permit number.
- 4) Enter the appropriate inspection code.
- 5) Enter the requested inspection date.
- 6) Enter the time preference for either AM or PM.
- 7) Choose whether or not to leave a voice message for the inspector.

Once you have scheduled the inspection, you will be able to:

- Request another inspection, same permit.
- Request another inspection, different permit.
- Receive a confirmation number and hang up.
- Return to the main menu.

INSTALLATION ON PERMANENT FOUNDATION

Application Requirements:

- Provide copy of grant deed for property (same name as owner)
- Provide title search for mobile home or manufactured home EXCEPTION: not required for new mobile homes
- Provide plot plan with all setback dimensions and accessory structures, such as garage or carport (Please make sure that size of mobile home, setbacks, covered parking, lot size, lot coverage percentage, and type of skirting are clearly stated on the plot plan.)
- Submit three grading plans, one Joshua Tree inspection report and one suspension agreement if installing a new or used mobile home on a new lot
- Provide photos of mobile home
- Provide manufacturer's installation instructions and HCD approved foundation system signed by a licensed California engineer Complete HCD form 433A in full and submit to Development Department, Building Division (same name as owner)
- Pay State fee of \$11.00 per section (check made payable to "HCD")
- Pay County recording fee of \$24.00 (check made payable to "San Bernardino County Recorder")
- Surrender certificate of title and registration, along with any license plates or decals issued by HCD or DMV (If there is a lien holder on the title report, the lien holder must give written consent for the placement of the unit on a permanent foundation system. The lender's letter should provide the serial number and APN or address) EXCEPTION: not required for new mobile homes

Inspection Requirements:

New mobile homes on permanent foundation require the following inspections:

- 1) Footings/Forms
- 2) Setdown
- 3) Sewer
- 4) Water Service
- 5) Gas Line Air Test
- 6) Service/Sub Panel
- 7) Final Construction

Existing mobile homes placed on permanent foundation require the following inspections:

- 1) Footings/Forms
- 2) Final Construction

INSTALLATION IN A PARK

Application Requirements:

Complete **Mobile Home Installation Information** handout to include the following information:

- Plot plan
- Tenant name
- Park name
- Park address
- Space number
- Owner name
- Owner address
- Contractor name
- Contractor address
- Contractor license number
- Installation approval from park owner, operator or manager
- Mobile home support plan (HCD approved engineered tie down system)
- Pier spacing
- Mobile home data*
- Tiedowns*
- Footing Materials*
- Lot utility services*
- Load bearing supports*

Inspection Requirements:

- 1) Tiedown
- 2) Sewer
- 3) Water Service
- 4) Gas Line Air Test
- 5) Service/Sub Panel
- 6) Final Construction

FEE SCHEDULES

Installation on Permanent Foundation:

All mobile homes placed on permanent foundation are assessed the same fees as new residential construction. Please refer to the **Residential Fee Schedule** handout for a complete listing of applicable fees. The only exception to these fees are the Development Impact Fees (DIF) for existing mobile homes. DIF fees for existing mobile homes placed on permanent foundation will be based on the date of original set down as indicated on the following schedule.
