

The Victorville Military Banner Program began as an effort to pay tribute and to recognize Victorville's military population who are serving in a presidential decreed war zone

The program is funded through sponsorships, which enable the purchase and placement of the banners on City lampposts. The banners have the service person's name and military branch, with an acknowledgement of thanks for their service. At the end of their tour, the banners are presented to the soldier as a keepsake.
