Recycling is Good Business

Hundreds of businesses in Victorville are doing their part to recycle and save resources.

Over 500 locations are participating in the City of Victorville's Business Recycling Program.

These businesses recycled over 3,560 tons in 2008—equivalent to about 790 trash trucks full!

The Daily Press is a model for outstanding recycling by a business!

The Daily Press recycles its overprint newspapers, the end sections of newspaper rolls from the printing press, corrugated cardboard, scrap metal, and wood and plastic pallets.

The Daily Press offices also recycle office paper and CRV bottles and cans.

In 2007, the Daily Press recycled 982 tons of materials! By the time the Daily Press is done recycling, there isn't much left that needs to be thrown in the trash.

The Daily Press also takes the next step—it "completes the recycling cycle"—because it USES recycled newsprint to print each day's newspapers.

The standard paper it uses is 50% recycled content. So, last week's Daily Press could be this week's Daily Press...and next week's Daily Press!
