Curbside Christmas Tree Pick Up

December 29th, 2008 through January 10th, 2009

Good news! Your natural, unflocked Christmas tree can now be put out for curbside collection. The City's hauler, Victorville Disposal, will pick up the trees separately from trash. The trees will eventually be chipped and turned into mulch.

WHAT?

- ✓ **ONLY NATURAL, UNFLOCKED TREES can be accepted.**
- ✓ No flocked trees or artificial trees can be accepted.
- ✓ Do not put trees in plastic bags.

HOW?

- ✓ Trees must be cut to 4 foot lengths.
- ✓ Remove wooden or metal stands, wire, nails, and any other objects from the tree before putting it at the curb. The trees are going to be chipped and used for mulch. **Wooden stands, decorations, and/or any metal objects create hazards when run through chipping equipment, so please make sure your tree is clean!**
- ✓ Put the tree at the curb (not in the can) on your pick up day. Note: DO NOT put your tree in your trash or recycle can.

NOTE: This program is for residential customers on cart service only. No businesses or bin customers.

WHEN?

- ✓ Put your tree out on your service day. Trees will be collected during the weeks of December 29th and January 5th, on your normal pick up day.
- ✓ Remember: Because of the Christmas and New Year's Day holidays, trash and recycling pick up will be one day later than usual Thursday and Friday customers.

What About Flocked or Artificial Trees? Flocked or artificial trees can be cut down to size and can be put in the regular green trash can. Residents of single-family homes can also call Victorville Disposal Company at 245-8607 to schedule a free bulky item pick up of these items. You can also haul your flocked or artificial tree to the County landfill. The County landfill disposal fee is \$12 for up to 300 pounds of trash. Call the County at 1-800-722-8004 for more information on the landfill.
