Victorville Fire Chief Sid Hultquist has issued a warning to Victorville residents to avoid traveling in and around Victorville as flooding problems continue throughout the City's streets. The brunt of this winter's storm is expected to hit Victorville around 4 p.m.

According to the City officials, many of the City's streets are flooded and barricades have been placed at many locations throughout the City. Residents are urged to remain indoors if possible, and motorists are urged to avoid driving around barricades. The Fire Department has rescued a number of motorists that all drove around the barricades. La Mesa Road remains closed due to a sink hole.

Sandbags are available at Victorville fire stations.

The following streets are closed:

- Hickory Ave @ Sitting Bull Street
- Hughes @ Avalon Road
- Avalon Road @ Molino Drive
- Pebble Beach Road @ wash Area
- Cataba Road between Eucalyptus Street & Verano Street
- Turner Road between Phantom East & National Trails Highway
- Calgo Lane between Barranca & Village Drive
- Puesta Del Sol Drive Between Cazadero Road, Barranca Street & wash
- Sueno Lane to the wash
- La Mesa between Amargosa to Del Gado Road
- Del Gado Rd. between Palmdale Road & Anacapa Road
- Rodeo Drive @ wash cross of Seneca Road
- Bear Valley Road @ Oro Grand Wash #2 Lane, West Bound
- Nisqualli Road between 11th Ave to Balsam Ave (Signal in 4-way flash due to road closure)
- Balsam, between Nisqualli Road to Lone Star
