Closed Session Discussion on Mall Project Now Available to Public

Victorville, CA – On July 17, 2012, the City of Victorville City Council agreed to waive their closed session privileges of confidentiality and authorized the release of closed session discussions and information.

This action was taken due to public interest in a development agreement with Macerich and questions regarding closed session deliberations. In an effort to be completely transparent, the City of Victorville is now posting the City Clerk's notes from a closed session meeting held on February 15, 2011 as well as audio recordings from closed session meetings held on June 21, 2011 and July 3, 2012. This is the first use of the new policy adopted March 1, 2011, when the City first started recording closed session discussions.

The approval of the development agreement secures the ongoing improvements of the Mall of Victor Valley and in the ongoing effort to attract future investments in our local economy.
