Animal Control Question & Answers

If my animal is missing, where do I go to look for it?

All animals picked up within the City limits of Victorville are taken to the Victor Valley Animal Protective League (see information above).

What are the benefits of microchipping my dog? Where can I have it done?

Microchips are an inexpensive and permanent method of identification, unlike tags that can be removed. They help quickly identify your pet if lost and ending up at a shelter, and information can be easily updated. You can contact your veterinarian to have a microchip inserted, or call the Victorville Animal Care and Control at (760) 955-5089 to make an appointment. Our charge is \$15.00. *(The City does not microchip cats at the present time.)*

Are cats required to be licensed?

No, cat licensing is strictly voluntary. We do encourage people to license their cats so that they can be returned if picked up wearing their license.

I live in Spring Valley Lake and have a problem with a neighbor's dog?

The City of Victorville has no jurisdiction in the Spring Valley Lake or Mountain View Acres areas of Victorville. These are County areas so you must contact San Bernardino County Animal Control at 1-800-472-5609.

What you need to know about licensing your dog . . .

Every dog that lives in the City limits must be licensed and vaccinated against rabies in accordance with the City of Victorville Municipal Code. This helps protect the general health, safety and welfare of all persons within the City.

New residents have 60 days to acquire a license for their dog(s), and persons renewing a dog license have 30 days following the expiration/renewal date.

In addition, no more than three dogs or cats can be maintained at a single residence.

Licensing is easy! You don't even need to bring your dog in - just bring the application below, with proof of rabies vaccination and certificate of sterility if applicable, to the Victorville City Hall, Cashier's Window, 14343 Civic Drive, M-Th 7:30 - 5:30 or the Public Works Yard at 14177 McArt Rd., M-Th 7:00 - 4:00. You may also mail your application to Victorville Animal Care and Control, PO Box 5001, Victorville, CA 92393.
