# City of Victorville Veteran's Day Parade Official Rules Agreement

The Parade Rules Agreement must be signed along with the Parade Application.

- The City of Victorville has the right to remove from the parade any organization, group and/or individual who do not follow the rules and regulations.
- Prospective entrants must submit the official application(s) prior to the entry deadline for consideration by the City of Victorville Parade Committee.
- No political campaigns will be accepted in the parade. Use of political signs, or units advocating political or social positions or issues are not permitted.
- Distribution of any substance (i.e. candy), literature, or objects (i.e. balloons, toys) either from the parade entry or by individuals associated with the parade entry, will not be tolerated on the parade route. Entries who do not comply with this rule will be removed from the parade.
- In the event of cancellation, notification will be made on the morning of the parade via Parade Committee staff. There will be no alternate parade date.
- Parade participants are not allowed to carry or use firearms, fireworks or open flames without the approval from the Parade Committee.
- Use and/or possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are forbidden.

I, the undersigned, understand the following:

\* I am aware that recreational activities can be hazardous and I am voluntarily participating in these activities with knowledge of the hazards involved and hereby agree to accept any and all risks of injury or death. The City is not responsible for participants' injuries or damages occurring from "hazardous recreation activities" (CA Government Code 831.7). \* The City does not provide participants with medical insurance or treatment for injuries. \* I agree to hold harmless and release the City of Victorville, its officers, agents and employees from any and all liability arising from or related to my participation in the City of Victorville program activities. This release includes, but not limited to, all liability for death, personal injury or property damage resulting from the active or passive negligence of the City of Victorville or its agents or any defective or hazardous condition of any property or equipment owned, operated or maintained by the City of Victorville. \*I am responsible for any loss, theft or damage to either personal or city equipment, articles and/or facilities while using said equipment, articles and/or facilities.

The City of Victorville, the members of the Parade Committee and any other authorized personnel representing the Veteran's Day Parade shall not be held liable for any type of physical injury or accident, which might be sustained by any and all participants in the Veteran's Day Parade.

The Liability Release Statement is signed with the full knowledge of all members of our entry participating in the Veteran's Day Parade.

The undersigned certifies that the forgoing application has been read and understood and any statements made in connection with the application are true and accurate. The applicant agrees to comply with all the rules and regulations established by the Parade Committee.
