Victorville, CA—The City of Victorville will host a community blood drive with the American Red Cross on Wednesday, June 22 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. in Conference Room D at Victorville City Hall located at 14343 Civic Drive.

“The City of Victorville is committed to strengthening our community and helping meet hospital and patient needs through blood donations,” said Christian Guntert, Director of Community Services. “We urge community members to donate blood and help ensure that patients in local hospitals have a supply of blood ready and waiting before an emergency occurs.”

Blood is a perishable product that can only come from volunteer blood donors. With someone in the U.S. needing blood every two seconds, blood products must be constantly replenished, according to the Red Cross.

Donors with all blood types are needed, especially those with types O negative, A negative and B negative.
