CITY OF VICTORVILLE WILL MOVE ANIMAL CARE & CONTROL SERVICES TO CITY HALL

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: July 31, 2017

VICTORVILLE, Calif. – Today, the City of Victorville announced plans to move its Animal Care and Control Services to City Hall as of Aug. 14. To consolidate resources and improve service, residents will be able to apply for dog licensing, file reports, schedule microchip appointments and pay fines at City Hall. The City's shelter services are still being provided at Victor Valley Animal Protective League on Zuni Road in Apple Valley. The public is advised that no animals are permitted in Victorville City Hall.

On Aug. 13, the City's Animal Care and Control Office on Amargosa Road will be closed to the public, except for microchip appointments that are scheduled in advance at City Hall or via the Animal Control phone number at (760) 955-5089.
