What goes in the Blue Recycling Barrel?

PAPER CARBOARD



- Carboard Boxes
- Clean Dry Paper
- Cereal Boxes
- Advertisements
- Newspapers
- Junk Mail
- Magazines

PLASTIC CONTAINERS



- Plastic Jars
- Yogurt Cups
- Shampoo Bottles
- Plastic Bottles
- Milk Jugs
- Soda Bottles
- Water Bottles

TIN ALUMINUM



- Aluminum Beverage Cans
- Soda & Juice Cans
- Beer Cans
- Empty Food Cans
- EMPTY Aerosol Cans
- Clean Aluminum Foil
- Pet Food Cans

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS



- Soda Bottles
- Glass Jars
- Food Bottles
- Beer Bottles
- Wine Bottles
- NO dishes, cups, windows, pyrex, etc.*

Place all cans, glass bottles/jars, plastic containers, papers and cardboard into your BLUE recycling bin. Make sure to empty and rinse cans and bottles before recycling. Put your blue bin out at the curb by 6 a.m. on your recycling day. Put the bin at least two feet away from mailboxes, cars, or other obstructions. No plastic bags in recycle barrel, please! The plastic bags jam up our sorting machines.



What About CRV?

Keep CRV beverage containers separate from your other recyclables, then redeem CRV for cash at a local buy-back recycle center. OR, just put CRV in with other recyclables in your blue barrel and they will be recycled through the City program.

DO NOT put Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) in the recycling barrel or trash. Please take it to the HHW Collection Center free of charge.

Typical HHW items accepted include:

- Paints and Paint Thinner
- Auto Fluids, Motor Oils and Filters
- Household Cleaners
- Yard Chemicals and Pesticides
- Spray Cans
