NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR DRAFT THIRD YEAR ACTION PLAN FOR FY 2019-2020 AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Victorville will open a public comment period for the draft Third Year Action Plan for FY 2019-2020. The plan will be available for public review and comment for 30 days beginning April 19, 2019 through May 18, 2019.

Additionally, all interested citizens and agencies are invited to attend a public hearing on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at the City of Victorville Council Chambers, 14343 Civic Drive, Victorville, CA 92392, to comment on the draft Third Year Action Plan FY 19-20 and the proposed projects for the City's Community Planning and Development (CPD) grant program. The CPD Grant program consists of two federal programs, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and the HOME Investment Partnerships program, as further described herein.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides grant funding to the City of Victorville (the "City") under the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") and to the Apple Valley/Victorville HOME Consortium (the "Consortium") under the Home Investment Partnership ("HOME") program. As such, the City and the Consortium are responsible to produce a multi-year planning document known as the Consolidated Plan (the "ConPlan") for the awarded funds under these grants. The ConPlan is a comprehensive analysis of current market conditions, housing and community development needs, population demographics and a five year strategy to address those needs. Additionally, the plan identifies homeless and special needs activities. The City is required to update the ConPlan through an annual Action Plan.

For Fiscal Year 2019-2020 HUD has allocated \$1,343,801 in CDBG funds and \$462,505 in HOME funds. Prior year CDBG funding in the amount of \$1,928.45 is also available for reprogramming. The proposed projects for FY 19-20 are the following:
