BUSINESS ELIGIBILITY

- Located within a Victorville CDBG Target Area
- Have a low income business owner (eligible as Micro-Enterprise Activity with less than 5 employees including business owner), OR at least 51% of employees are low-to-moderate income persons (Special Economic Development Activity)
- Operational for at least one year
- Demonstrated income loss due to COVID-19

FUNDS ARE LIMITED

Preference will be given to businesses located in the Old Town area, and minority or female-owned businesses.

Applications must be submitted online at vv.city/reopen and received by the City no later than October 11, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.
