- ☺ Computer/Copy Paper
- ☺ White & Colored Paper
- ☺ Legal Pads
- ☺ Construction Paper
- ☺ Stapled Paper
- ☺ Drawing Paper
- ☺ File Folders
- ☺ Fax Paper
- ☺ Envelopes
- ☺ Post-It Notes
- ☺ Brochures
- ☺ Index Cards
- ☺ Catalogs
- ☺ Newspapers
- ☺ Phonebooks
- ☺ Magazines
- ☺ Flattened Cardboard
- ☺ Empty Plastic Containers, Tubs, Jars, and Trays (#1 - #7)
- ☺ Empty Aluminum & Tin Food Cans
- ☺ Books



Remember these items **CANNOT** be Recycled and should be placed in the trash can at school:

- ☹ Food Waste
- ☹ Bathroom Waste
- ☹ Yard Waste
- ☹ Styrofoam
- ☹ Plastic Bags
- ☹ Pizza boxes (the soiled part)
- ☹ Pencil Shavings
- ☹ Rubber Bands
- ☹ Napkins
- ☹ Paper Towels
- ☹ Tissues
- ☹ Paper Cups and Plates
- ☹ Waxed Paper or Stickers
- ☹ Candy/Gum Wrappers
