

Recreation Assistance Program (R.A.P.) Information

The Recreation Assistance Program is to help children and families with limited financial resources to participate in recreation programs and activities.

Qualifications

Age: Participant must be 17 years or younger; documented with birth certificate.

Residency: Participant must live in Victorville zip codes 92392, 92394 & 92395; documented with photo identification and current utility bill with same name.

Income: Participants' household maximum gross annual income per chart below.

Proof of income required. **Acceptable Documents:** Current tax return, 60 days' pay stubs, monthly statements from government income.

- Swim Lessons (Group Setting)

Award: Amount varies dependent on program and family qualifications. A maximum of 100% of registration for group swim lessons, 50% of registration for basketball, preschool, and camp.

Max Award: \$100 per participant for the 1st year and \$50 per participant for the 2nd year. No more than two applications may be submitted within a 3-year period.

Documentation Required

- Proof of residency: driver's license /CA ID **AND** current utility bill.
- Proof of income: 60 days' current paystubs for each employed adult or adults, and last year's income tax return or award letter for unemployment or disability benefits or Public Assistance benefits.
- Proof of age and parent: Birth Certificate or Court document
- Proof of Guardianship: Court document.

Applications accepted at Hook Community Center

Monday-Thursday 8:00am-4:30pm, Friday 8:00am-3:30pm.

Applications are reviewed within 7 business days of submission.

If approved, the applicant has 7 business days from notification to complete registration and payment (if applicable) or application is denied.

Recreation Assistance Program (R.A.P.) Code of Conduct & Policies

Purpose: All youth participating in City of Victorville Recreation Scholarship Program will have the opportunity to play, learn new skills, and have fun in a safe and pleasant environment. Disruptive, disrespectful, or abusive behavior displayed by the participants, parents, or spectators, is not acceptable.

The following code of conduct and policies shall apply to all participants and parents in the City of Victorville Recreation programs and in City facilities, and will be enforced before, during, and after all activities, programs, and events.

Please read these guidelines to your child to help them understand the meaning of **acceptable behavior**. Your time and cooperation in following the Code of Conduct will help your child and others maximize their enjoyment and benefit from the programs offered by the City of Victorville.

1. Attend a minimum of 80% of the session; attending less jeopardizes future scholarship approval.
2. No refunds will be given for any reason. No exceptions.
3. Failure to complete registration and payment (if applicable) within 7 days of approval will result in denial of application.
4. Follow the example and direction set by coaches/instructors/staff.
5. Share concerns and problems regarding the actions of other participants with the adult leader, rather than reacting negatively (verbally or physically) to others.
6. Use respectful language when speaking with leaders, volunteers, instructors, and other participants. Verbal profanity, profane gestures, or threats upon any other participants, volunteer, instructor, or leader will not be tolerated and are grounds for rejection from the activity.
7. Respect the property of others. Do not take or use the property of others without permission.

Failure to follow the Code of Conduct and Policy may result in future scholarship denial.
