FIREWORKS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE CITY OF VICTORVILLE—\$1000 FINE

The City of Victorville prohibits the use of fireworks. Discharging fireworks is subject to a minimum fine of \$1,000 issued to the Resident/Tenant or property where the violation occurs.

The City of Victorville will continue to utilize Police, Code Enforcement and Animal Care and Control Officers to investigate all fireworks reports during late evening hours and upon review of online report and photographs, may assess fines on the following day.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING

USE OF FIREWORKS PROHIBITED - All fireworks including safe and sane fireworks – are prohibited in the City of Victorville.

PUBLIC REPORTING - Impacted and traumatized community members are encouraged to report fireworks. Reports can be submitted anonymously via our online reporting tool: vv.city/reportfireworks. Please include the address of the fireworks activity and any photographs.

ASSESSMENT OF \$1,000 MINIMUM FINE - Fireworks discharged by an individual or from a property will result in a minimum \$1,000 fine issued to the individual or the property owner of record.

PROPERTY OWNER RESPONSIBILITY - Property owners and rental property owners are responsible for activities on their property or nuisance activity related to their rental business /tenants therefore, property owners may also be fined. Please review this notice with tenants.

REVIEW OF PHOTOGRAPHIC EVIDENCE - Enforcement officers will review photographic evidence submitted by residents or City staff and may issue fines forthwith or on the following day upon review.

FREE BULKY ITEM PICK-UP: Residents of single-family houses in the City of Victorville can schedule a FREE pick-up of bulky items two times per year, with up to 5 items collected per pick up. Bulky item pick-up is for furniture, mattresses, tires, and bundles of brush—not boxes, bags, or other trash. Call Victorville Disposal at 760-245-8607 to schedule a pick-up.

FREE RECYCLING OF APPLIANCES, TV's, COMPUTERS, MATTRESSES/BOXSPRINGS, and other RECYCLABLES AT THE CITY OF VICTORVILLE RECYCLING CENTER: The Victorville Recycling Drop-off Center is located at 15164 Anacapa Rd., in Victorville. Open M-F, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and SAT 8 a.m. to noon.

FREE DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTES: Dispose of motor oil, filters, paint, household chemicals, batteries, cooking oil, and fluorescent lights at the City of Victorville HHW Collection Center. Located on Loves Lane, off of Desert Knoll Drive, behind the County Fairgrounds. Open W and SUN from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

FREE DISPOSAL OF TIRES FOR VICTORVILLE RESIDENTS: City residents can dispose of up to 5 car or light truck tires, on or off rim, free of charge at the Victorville Recycling Drop-off Center. Photo ID and current utility bill showing City service address are required for free tire drop off. No semi tires or equipment tires. No business tires. Recycling Center located at 15164 Anacapa Rd. Open M-F 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and SAT 8 a.m. to noon.

ORDER EXTRA TRASH AND/OR RECYCLE BARRELS: You can get an extra curbside trash barrel for a fee. Extra recycling barrels are free. Call City of Victorville Customer Service at 760-955-5001 to order extra barrels.

FREE DUMP/CLEANUP EVENTS: Go to www.VictorvilleCA.gov/DumpltRightVV for info about Free Dump Day events 3 times/year. Info is also included in your water/trash bill.

TEMPORARY BINS & DUMPSTERS: Do you have a BIG cleaning project? Victorville Disposal has temporary bins and roll-off dumpsters for rent. Call 760-245-8607 for more information.

VICTORVILLE LANDFILL: San Bernardino County's Victorville Landfill is located at 18600 Stoddard Wells Rd., and is open 6 days per week, Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. You can dispose of extra trash easily and lawfully at a reasonable cost.
