California Legislature approved Assembly Bill 2 (Stats. 2015, c. 319, as amended), and thereby enacted Part 1 (commencing with Section 62000) of Division 4 of Title 6 of the Government Code (“CRIA Law”) to create a planning and financing tool for local governments to support the economic revitalization of the community and utilize property tax increment revenue generated within the Old Town Specific Plan area to fund revitalization activities like infrastructure improvements; low and moderate-income housing development; real property acquisition; loans or grants to owners and tenants to improve, rehabilitate and retrofit buildings; and business assistance.

This Board consists of three members of the City Council, which term shall run concurrent to their term of office and two public members one of which will serve an

initial two-year term and one will serve a four-year term. All future public Members shall be appointed for terms of four (4) years.

Per Government Code §54972 each legislative body shall prepare an appointments list of all regular and ongoing boards, commissions, and committees which are appointed by the legislative body of the local agency.
