

PROPER DISPOSAL OF THE AMERICAN FLAG



Do you have an American Flag that needs to be retired?

Bring it to one of our drop-off sites for a proper, dignified disposal.

The United States Flag Code states: "The Flag, when it is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem of display, should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning."

The City of Victorville, Environmental Programs Division, is working with Cemex Cement to offer a proper American Flag disposal method for residents and businesses in the Victor Valley.

Flags requiring disposal can be dropped off at these four locations:

- **Victorville Recycle Drop-off Center**, 15164 Anacapa Road
M - F 8:00 - 4:00 and Saturdays 8 am—noon
- **Victorville City Hall**, 14343 Civic Drive — M - TH 7:30 - 5:30
Deliver to front reception desk or Conservation Division next to Fire Department
- **Hook Community Center**, 14973 Joshua Street — M - TH 9:00 - 5:00
Deliver to front desk
- **Victorville City Library**, 15011 Circle Drive - *Deliver to front desk*
M - TH 9:00 - 8:00 FRI 9:00 - 6:00 SAT 9:00 - 5:00

City staff will deliver the flags to Cemex Cement. Cemex staff will hold a flag ceremony with the local Boy Scouts, after which flags will be placed in the cement kiln/furnace for proper, dignified burning.
